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happening in Africa? Are these revolutions to remove humiliation and oppressions of Africa? Let us take the latest in Ghana.

"The enemies of Africa are now jubilant. There is jubilation in Salisbury and Johannesburg. Even a fool would begin to wonder whether the revolutions would help Africa. What was Kwame trying to do? He stood for the liberation of Africa. There is not a single leader in Africa more committed to this than Kwame. Whom did he anger? Certainly not Africa and not even friends of Africa.

"Kwame was absolutely committed to true independence. It cannot be denied that there is no neo-colonialism in Africa. The freedom of having a flag and national anthem is not a real freedom. There are some countries which say yes when they mean no, and no when they mean yes. You have to go to the ambassadors of aid-giving countries to get the truth.

"NKRUMAH was against this. In this he was not angering Africa. Kwame was committed to the unity of Africa. Africa can only be

strong through unity to shake away all forms of oppression and colonialism. This is a fact. Divided as we are, we shall be weak.

"Kwame was completely uncompromising on African unity. Who was he angering? Not Africa. Kwame was also committed to industrialization of Ghana. He believed that as long as we remained producers of raw materials we become prey to industrialized countries.
