Come join Chicago's most distinguished business leaders, in the first of a series of luncheons, designed to solve some of the serious business and economic problems facing the Bilalian (black) community.

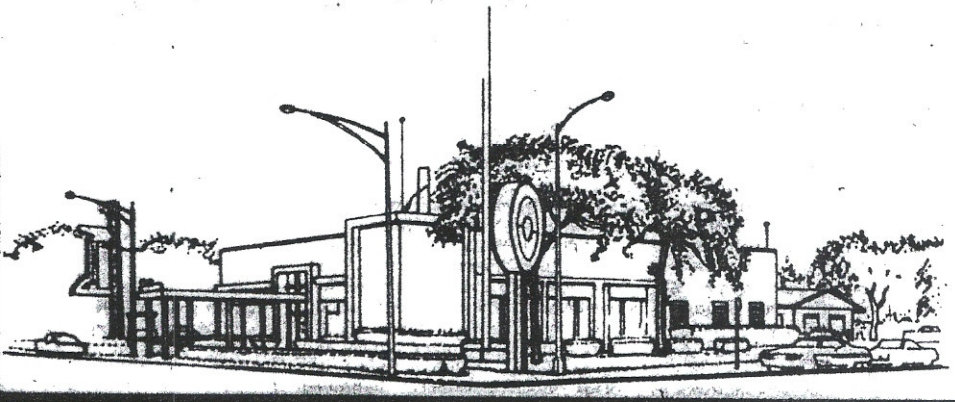
Two brand new Bilalian News advertising programs will also be introduced.
